U15 Public Research Universities

Polytechnic & Applied Colleges

Institutions offering hands-on diplomas, co-op work terms, and applied bachelor's degrees closely linked with Ontario industry sectors and corporate workforce demands.

ESSENTIAL RULE Designated Learning Institution (DLI) Verification

To receive a valid Canadian Study Permit, your Letter of Acceptance (LOA) must be issued by a government-approved **Designated Learning Institution (DLI)**. Furthermore, under newly updated immigration regulations, the specific program of study must remain actively eligible for the Post-Graduation Work Permit (PGWP).

Please Note: All campus access, faculty briefings, and institutional sessions are conducted strictly in accordance with institutional guidelines and are subject to formal scheduling authorization from the respective universities and colleges.

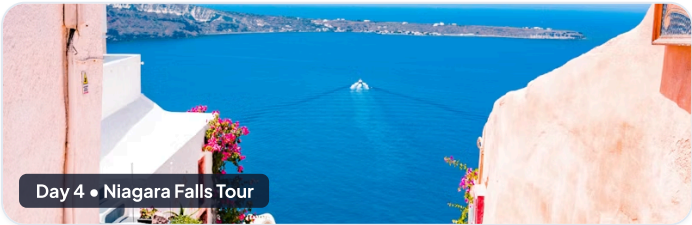

NAVIGATING NEW IRCC IMMIGRATION POLICIES

Essential Compliance Framework for Study Permits, Visas, and Work Allowances

 MANDATORY PROVINCIAL ATTESTATION LETTER (PAL) REQUIREMENT

Under the revised IRCC policy framework, international students applying for college diplomas, post-graduate certificates, or undergraduate degrees **must secure a Provincial Attestation Letter (PAL)** from the province of Ontario alongside their formal university Letter of Acceptance (LOA). *Note: Master’s and Doctoral degree applicants are currently exempt from the PAL requirement.*

HOURS **24-Hour Off-Campus Work Limit**

Eligible international students studying full-time at a DLI are permitted to work up to **24 hours per week off-campus** during regular academic sessions, and full-time during scheduled academic breaks.

FUNDS **Updated Cost-of-Living Benchmark**

Study permit applicants must demonstrate verified financial sufficiency (\$20,635+ CAD cost-of-living benchmark for a single applicant, plus first-year tuition fees and travel costs) via bank statements or GICs.

SPOUSAL **Spousal Open Work Permit Rules**

Spousal Open Work Permits (SOWP) are now focused primarily on the spouses of international students enrolled in Master’s, Doctoral, and select designated professional degree programs.

BIOMETRICS **VFS Global & Biometrics Protocol**

Biometrics appointments at local VFS Global centres must be scheduled immediately following application submission to prevent processing delays across regional visa offices worldwide.

1. DLI LOA Issuance

2. Provincial Attestation (PAL)

3. GIC / Financial POF

4. IRCC Permit Approval

Aligning Academic Credentials with Long-Term Canadian Economic Mobility

MAJOR POLICY OPPORTUNITY Updated Rule Framework

3-Year PGWP Fast-Track for Master’s Degree Graduates

Under updated IRCC guidelines, graduates of eligible master’s degree programs can now qualify for a **full 3-year Post-Graduation Work Permit**, even if their course duration was under two years (e.g., 12 to 16-month accelerated programs). This provides maximum runway to accumulate Canadian work experience.

🎯 Field-of-Study Requirements

For college graduates, PGWP eligibility is now closely tied to high-demand occupational sectors: **STEM, Healthcare, Skilled Trades, Agriculture, and Transportation**. Our academic advisors help verify eligible CIP codes.

🗣️ Language Proficiency Benchmarks

Applicants submitting PGWP applications must demonstrate Canadian Language Benchmark (CLB) scores: **CLB 7 for university degree graduates** and **CLB 5 for college diploma graduates**.

🚀 THE STUDY-TO-PR PROGRESSION FRAMEWORK

STEP 1

Canadian Study

Graduate from a recognized Ontario DLI.

STEP 2

PGWP Work Permit

Secure open work permit for up to 3 years.

STEP 3

Skilled Experience

Accumulate Canadian experience (TEER 0–3).

STEP 4

Permanent Residence

Apply via Express Entry (CEC) or Ontario PNP.

CAMPUS PROTOCOL & PROFESSIONALISM

1. Research Before You Arrive

Review each university's specific faculty departments, prerequisite courses, and admission averages before setting foot on campus.

2. Ask Targeted Questions

Focus on co-op placement statistics, undergraduate lab assistant opportunities, and on-campus international student support programs.

3. Professional Networking

Collect business cards and LinkedIn connections from international student advisors, student union leaders, and professors.

POST-VISIT EXECUTION CHECKLIST

-  **Rank Preferred DLIs:** Narrow choices based on campus culture, city lifestyle, and budget.
-  **Prepare Financial POF:** Arrange verified bank funds or Canadian GICs (\$20,635+ CAD).
-  **Request Provincial Attestation (PAL):** Coordinate with university admissions teams.
-  **Submit IRCC Study Permit:** Lodge file via TrueGlobal and CICC legal partners.
